General Information and Policies

Students will need to obtain a daily pass to come to the Media Center during their study blocks. They can get this pass **before** the school day. There will be a limited number of students allowed to obtain passes each day and each day will be different depending on the demand of the Media Center for classes and testing.

Students may come to the Media Center **anytime** to print, copy, or check out books. They will have to have a signed agenda.

Students may use the Media Center to read, check out books, research, write, seek help with assignments, print, use the computers, and to work quietly. They are expected to behave respectfully and not use the time for socialization or play. No food or drink is allowed. Cell phones will be dropped into a basket at the Media Center front counter. Students who choose to disregard these policies will be asked to leave.

Online Services

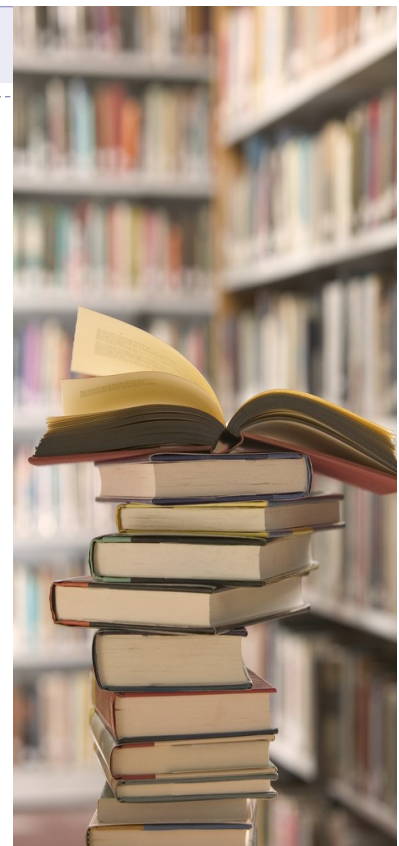
Athena — Online library book catalog system. Used to look at the books offered in the Media Center.
